WARRANT

HAMPSHIRE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, ss:

TO EITHER OF THE CONSTABLES OF THE TOWN OF HUNTINGTON IN, SAID COUNTY OF HAMPSHIRE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, GREETING:

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at Stanton Hall in said Huntington on Wednesday; February 17, 2010 at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$4,700.00 to Assessors' Revaluation Expenses (015137.005) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$15,000.00 to Legal Expenses (015151.000) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from The Wildlife Habitat Incentive Program (244034.000) to Highway Road Maintenance (015422.007) the sum of \$6,000.00 for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$2,000.00 to Street Lights account (015424.000) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$12,000.00 to Veterans' Relief Benefits (015543.001) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 6: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Water Reserves the sum of \$3,000.00 to Water Wages (015450.001) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 7: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Water Reserves the sum of \$18,000.00 to Water Improvements (015450.016) for on going expenses; or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Post Office, Moltenbrey's Market, Knightville Package Store, Norwich Fire Station and Town Hall, in said Town, fourteen (14) days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

HEREOF, fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doing thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
